



This document outlines key measures Riverside International Speedway is taking in consideration of COVID-19 precautions. While these measures will help keep our guests protected from COVID-19, the ultimate responsibility is on each person to make smart, safe, and healthy decisions in planning to attend and while at our events.

Know Before You Go | Grandstand | July 24, 2021

Capacity Management

- The grandstand is separated into zones of 250 fans each; fans must stay in the zone they are ticketed for
- You will receive a bracelet designated for your zone at entry and must wear it until you exit the facility
- Each zone will have a dedicated entry/exit, washrooms, and hand-washing station

Guest Criteria

MUST NOT attend if...

- Experiencing COVID-19 symptoms
- Diagnosed with or exposed to someone diagnosed with or exposed to COVID-19 in 14 days before the event
- Advised by the public health authorities, or are required to self-isolate, in the 14 days prior to the event

SHOULD NOT attend if...

- At high-risk for severe health issues

Anyone not adhering to COVID-19 protocols and policies will be asked to leave

Guest Screening

- Guests are required to acknowledge and agree to COVID-19 protocols and public health requirements
- Contact tracing information will be collected at entry for one person in each group

COVID-19 Prevention Supplies

- Hand sanitizer will be available at numerous locations throughout the facility
- Guests are encouraged to wash hands with soap and water frequently, especially after touching a shared surface
- If soap and water is not available, hand sanitizer should be used
- Guests should bring their own masks and personal COVID-19 prevention supplies

Face Masks

- Guests are required to wear a face mask at all times except when seated with their personal group
- If guests are unable to wear a mask for medical reasons they must wear a face shield

Distancing

- Guests must maintain a minimum two meter/six foot distance at all times from those not in their personal group (max 25 people); this includes the parking lot, to and from seating, while seated, to and from washrooms, and any line-ups they may incur while on site.

Tickets

- Be sure you bring a digital or paper copy of your ticket/s; they will be scanned at entry and void after that
- Know your zone entry location before you go; park as close as you can to that entry

Seating - All Bench Seats are General Admission

- Pre-determined family/social groups of up to 25 people can sit together without having to maintain distance in their group
- Masks can be removed while seated with your group
- Each group must be separated by at least two meters/six feet; bring a blanket, or markers available at entry to designate group space

Pit/Infield Access

- Limited to race team members only

Exiting

- During the event, re-entry will be permitted until 30 laps remain in the feature race; after that there will be no re-entry
- Guests who exit prior to the conclusion of an event must be properly distanced and wear masks
- At the conclusion of the event guests must exit as directed by staff, maintaining a two-meter distance from others

Spectator Parking Areas

- Distancing must be maintained while en route to and from point of entry; no tailgating pre or post event

Concessions

- Canteen service is open; sellers will be in each zone offering food and beverages

Smoking - Purple Zone Only

- There is a designated area for smoking in the Purple zone - no smoking in the grandstand or in other zones

Coolers/Bags/ Carry-In Food & Drinks

- Maximum cooler/bag size for carry-in food and non-alcoholic beverages is 14" x14" x 14"
- No alcohol, no glass containers; container caps must be sealed at your point entry; containers with removable lids must be empty at entry

Cleaning and Sanitizing

- Venue will be cleaned and sanitized regularly; frequently for high touch-point and traffic areas

Camping

- Unreserved and unserviced in section F1 only; self-contained RVs only - COVID-19 protocols in place

If You Become Unwell While On-Site

- You should remain in your seat and call 902-870-4117; an attendant will come to you for assessment
