



This document outlines key measures Riverside International Speedway is taking in consideration of COVID-19 precautions. While these measures will help keep our guests protected from COVID-19, the ultimate responsibility is on each person to make smart, safe, and healthy decisions in planning to attend and while at our events.

Know Before You Go | Grandstand | September 11, 2021

Guest Criteria

MUST NOT attend if...

- Experiencing COVID-19 symptoms
- Diagnosed with or exposed to someone diagnosed with or exposed to COVID-19 in 14 days before the event
- Advised by the public health authorities, or are required to self-isolate, in the 14 days prior to the event

Anyone not adhering to COVID-19 protocols and policies will be asked to leave

Face Masks

- Guests are required to wear a face mask at all times except when seated with their personal group (maximum 50)
- If guests are unable to wear a mask for medical reasons they must wear a face shield

Distancing

- Guests must maintain a minimum two meter/six foot distance at all times from those not in their personal group

Tickets

- Be sure you bring a digital or paper copy of your ticket/s; they will be scanned at entry and void after that
- Know your zone entry location before you go; park as close as you can to that entry

Grandstand Seating - All Bench Seats are General Admission

- The grandstand is separated into two areas - the main grandstand is the Red Zone and the turn 1-2 grandstand is the Yellow Zone and is licensed; there is no crossover between the two areas so please be sure to buy your ticket/s accordingly
- Pre-determined family/social groups of up to 50 people can sit together without having to maintain distance in their group; everyone in that group must be comfortable being within that group of close personal contacts
- Each group must be separated by at least two meters/six feet; bring a blanket, or use markers available at entry to designate group space - please be mindful of distance between your group and those around you when selecting your seats
- If you are uncomfortable with the distance between your group and another you are encouraged to move to another seating area within your zone, or seek assistance from the staff attendant in your zone
- The green stadium-type seats on the top two rows are reserved for the season by Premium Seat holders

Pit/Infield Access

- Limited to race team members only

Exiting

- During the event, re-entry will be permitted until 30 laps remain in the feature race (with a re-entry stamp) ; after that no re-entry
- Masks must be worn and distance maintained between groups when exiting the facility
- Please use the designated exit lane if exiting during the event

Spectator Parking Areas

- Distancing must be maintained while en route to and from point of entry; no tailgating pre or post event

Concessions

- Canteen service for food and non-alcoholic beverages is open with walk-up service; distance must be maintained if there is a line

Smoking/Vaping

- No smoking/vaping in grandstand seating areas - please use designated areas in each zone

Coolers/Bags/ Carry-In Food & Drinks

- Maximum cooler/bag size for carry-in food and non-alcoholic beverages is 14" x14" x 14"
- No alcohol, no glass containers; container caps must be sealed at your point entry; containers with removable lids must be empty at entry

Cleaning and Sanitizing

- Venue will be cleaned and sanitized regularly; frequently for high touch-point and traffic areas

Camping

- Unreserved and unserviced in section F1 only; self-contained RVs only - COVID-19 protocols in place

OHV/Golf Carts

- A permit is required to use an OHV or golf cart on RIS property (at any time); more info at [RiversideSpeedway.ca/event/ohv](https://www.RiversideSpeedway.ca/event/ohv)

- You should remain in your seat and call 902-870-4117; an attendant will come to you for assessment
