



Where is Riverside International Speedway?

- 101 Beaver Mountain Road, James River, Nova Scotia (approx. 15 km west of Antigonish)
- Adjacent to Trans Canada Highway 104, at Exit 30

What is this event?

- First-ever monster truck shows at Riverside International Speedway.
- Featuring six (6) USMT Monster Trucks and a stunt show.
- Two shows! June 2 @ 7:30 p.m. & June 3 @ 2:30 p.m.

Is this a family event?

- Absolutely! All ages are welcome; those under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Do you have spectator parking on-site?

- Yes, we have acres of spectator parking, free except for VIP area.

What are the ticket prices?

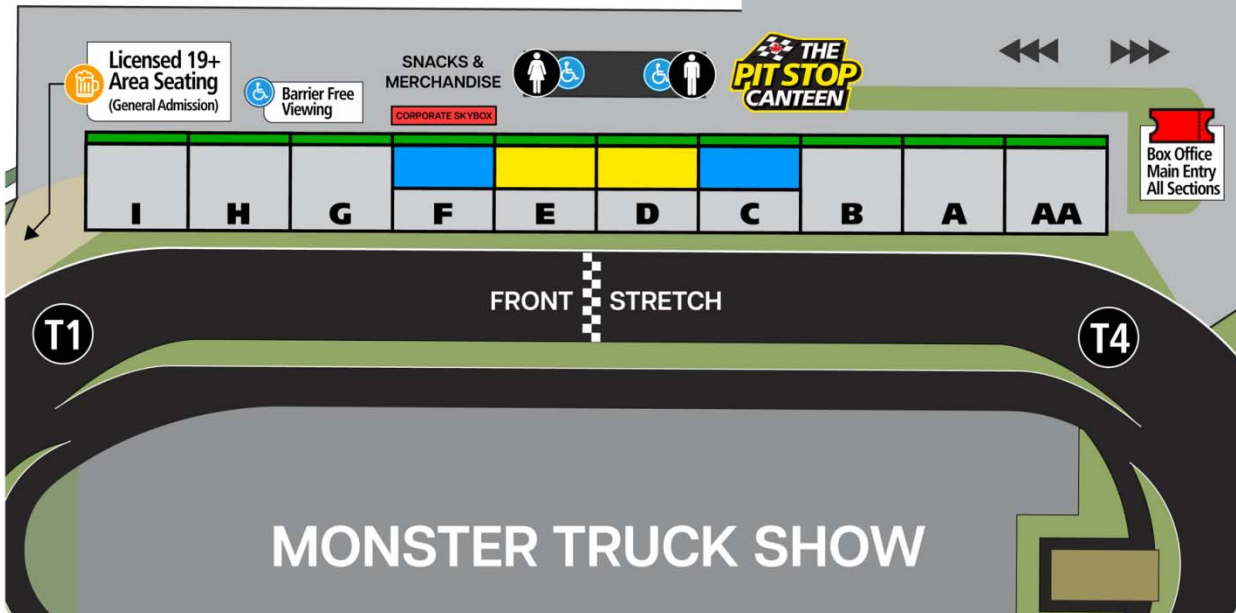
Tickets purchased in advance include free admission to the Pit Party on the day of the show for which the tickets are purchased. Pit Party tickets, if any remain, purchased at the gate will be \$5.00. Free tickets are not available in advance.

Note: HST is extra, free tickets available at the gate only with infant present.

Is the facility wheelchair accessible?

- We have an accessible viewing platform and accessible washrooms.

What is included with the VIP Passes?

- You get reserved seating at the center of the main grandstand - the best viewing; and
- Collectible VIP Pass & Lanyard; and
- Early Access, Express Entry; and
- Access to a VIP Parking Pass (one per order, per group).

What is the difference in VIP and VIP PLUS?

- VIP PLUS tickets are very limited in quantity; you get everything with the VIP Pass PLUS a
- Monster Ride in the official ride truck of the All Star Monster Truck Tour during the Pit Party.

What is the Pit Party?

- Access to the infield pre-show for up-close viewing on the monster trucks; and
- Driver autograph session.

How do I purchase tickets?

- Online at www.riversidespeedway.ca.
- Starting May 1, at our office in the Post Road Plaza (M-F, 8:30-12:30 & 1:30-4:30).
- Pending availability, at the gate on June 2 starting at 5 p.m. & June 3 starting at Noon.

We accept all major credit cards and bank debit cards online; as well as cash for in-person sales.

Tickets will be delivered digitally to the email address on your order within minutes of completing payment. You can print the ticket or save it by screenshot; either way the QR code must be presented when you enter the facility. It will be scanned and deactivated (good for one use only). All ticket sales are final, no refunds or exchanges.

Can anyone get a Monster Ride?

- Monster Rides are an all-ages experience. VIP PLUS Passes include Monster Rides and are the only way to pre-purchase them. If time and weather permits, Monster Rides may be available at the track for \$18.00 per person, all ages, cash only (admission ticket required to access).

Do you have a canteen?

- We have two! One in the main grandstand and one in the licensed area - both serving a variety of yummy hot food offerings, cold drinks and water.
- For these shows, we are offering a pre-paid Family Meal Deal with the purchase of your Monster Truck tickets. It is \$42.50 and includes (2) hamburgers, (2) hot dogs, (1) fries, (1) onion rings, and (4) drinks (pop, water, coffee/tea). With this you can use the Pit Stop Canteen Express Lane and spend less time in line.

Do you have a licensed area (for adult beverages)?

- Yes, it is located inside the facility; must be 19 or older to enter this area.
- Gov't-issued ID must be presented on request upon entering or while in this area.
- Limit of four beverages per purchase, for personal consumption only (no outside alcohol).

Can I bring my own food and drinks?

Yes, but no alcohol, glass bottles, or open containers (including coffee mugs, etc.) can be carried into the facility. Maximum bag size is 18" x 12" x 10", no hard coolers. Contents will be inspected at entry; contraband will be forfeited and entry may not be allowed (no refund).

Can I bring a personal bag, backpack, or other items?

- Yes, the maximum size is 18x12x10 (inches); all bags are subject to content search at entry.
- Items not permitted include, but are not limited to:
 - Alcohol and/or illegal substances
 - Glass and/or open beverage containers
 - Noisemakers, signs or anything we determine is a nuisance and interfering with others viewing the event
 - Umbrellas, strollers, tables, suitcases or other large bags, laser pointers, games or sporting equipment, drones
 - Weapons or items that can be used as a weapon (as determined by security)

Can I smoke inside the facility?

- Yes, tobacco products only, and only in designated smoking areas.

Can I bring my pet?

- Only licensed seeing eye dogs are permitted (license must be presented at entry).

Can I come and go during the event?

- Have your hand stamped as you exit and show it and your admission ticket on re-entry.

What if it rains?

- Rain will not force postponement or cancellation of an event. If in doubt please check with the venue before heading out; schedule changes will be posted on our website and social media pages and, time permitting may be emailed to advance ticket purchasers.

Can we camp on-site?

- Yes, with an advance reservation (available at www.riversidespeedway.ca).
- Self-contained RVs only.
- Number of people in camper cannot exceed manufacturer sleeping capacity of unit.

- Park and use the camping area at your own risk.

Do you have serviced sites?

- No, all sites are unserviced.

What are the check-in/check-out dates and times?

- Check-in
 - Thursday, June 1 from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m.
 - Friday, June 2 from Noon to 8 p.m.
 - Saturday, June 3 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- Check-out
 - Sunday, June 4 by Noon

Can I use my OHV, Golf Cart, etc. on-site?

It is the responsibility of the ticket holder to be aware of surroundings at all times and ticket holder is aware of and accepts those risks by entering the facility.
